4 YEAR OLD PROGRAM REPORT


The four-year-olds have settled into their respective groups with several of our children participating in both Yellow and Purple groups on the long days. Our new students have also found their place in the group and started reaching out for new friendships. The children have been very accommodating and accepting of this which has been a delight to watch.

The staff have been busy making modifications to the playroom recently including a new space area with astronaut costumes, a literacy area which has been converted to a post office, a new fairy area and new paints just to name a few of the spaces.

This month's focus is the post office area. In the post office area, children are encouraged to draw a picture/ attempt to write a letter for somebody, place it in an envelope with the recipient's address and a stamp before posting it in the red post box. It's a fun and educational away to promote literacy awareness in young children. We have recently added pretend postcards for the children to draw/ write on also. Both groups visited the post office recently, therefore this was a great opportunity to develop children's interest and understanding of how the mail system works. We will continue to extend on this over the coming weeks.



Our four-year olds are doing a fabulous job signing in every session. Everyone has had a go thus far which shows courage and motivation. We will continue with the signing in for the rest of the year and introduce the next phase (signing out as well) at a later date.



The transition from kindergarten to primary school is such a precious time in a child's life. It can bring on a range of emotions from happiness and excitement to anxiety and sadness. To alleviate the stress that some children may feel before starting school we have our school visits a bit earlier this year. Both groups will be visiting a BWPS prep classroom this term as well as several trips to the school's library for story time sessions. We also hope that the school might visit us later in the year as this has been done in the past.



3 YEAR OLD PROGRAM REPORT

The three-year-olds have had some cold weather lately on their Monday sessions. Winter has well and truly hit us so please make sure your child has plenty of warm layers in their bag and a warm coat to wear outdoors every session. At Bentleigh West Kindergarten we are big on active play no matter what the weather has forecasted, please bear this in mind when packing your child's bag each week.

Recently we have introduced an indoor/outdoor program where children can choose where they would like to play. There is a staff member in each space supporting and guiding the children as they are encouraged to make the choice whether they prefer to play indoors, outdoors or perhaps a bit of both. So far, this has been working well and the children have really enjoyed making their own choices.




This month's focus is the vet area. I can't emphasise how much our three-year-old children have loved playing in this area. In the vet area we have watched friendships blossom, with lots of sharing and imaginative play. It is such a popular area!! Children just love caring for animals at this age therefore this area has supported them in so many ways. Staff have added some scales to encourage children to weigh the animals and explore the concept of mass. We will continue making modifications to this area to support their learning in the coming weeks.

Recently we had the Australian Animals incursion (Wild Action) at kinder. We had discussions about the types of animals we might meet at kinder to probe the children's learning. Some of the children's suggestions included lizards, koalas, birds, echidnas and possums. Many children guessed correctly and the following animals came along; 'Lace Monitor' the lizard, a green tree frog, 'Sami the Kangaroo', 'Frank the Koala', Steve the Fresh Water Croc, 'Gremlin the Gang Gang Cockatoo', 'Gumnut the Sugar Glider Possum' 'Spikes the Echidna' and 'Charlie the Diamond Python'. The children learnt about the animals' habitat, diet, body parts and life span then the children all had the opportunity to have a feel of the animals.







The three-year-olds have loved songs and finger plays with props. We sang the 'Four Little Ducks' song recently and practised performing in front of our friends. This supports children to build confidence, language skills and a positive self-concept from a young age.
