He drank up all the water And ate a bar of soap. And now he's in his bed, With bubbles in his throat.


Bubble, Bubble, POP!

LEARNING EXPERENCES

Numeracy-

Children, I would like you to play a maths game with Mum or Dad or your older siblings. It is called Race to fill the cup. You need-

- Cups which are all the same size. (important for fairness!) You will need to count how many people are playing and give each person a cup.
- A dice.
- Some small items to fill your cups with. You can use Lego pieces or marbles, or something similar. They must fit in the cups and fill at least one of them. See what you have at home. You might need to go on a hunt.

How to play-

- 1) Sit in a circle.
- 2) Roll the dice. If you roll 6, place 6 items in your cup. If you roll 2, place 2 items in your cup etc...
- 3) The winner is the person to fill their cup first.

Parents, Please encourage careful counting. You can also talk about more and less. You can observe or ask them if they need to count the numbers on the dice or if they can tell by just looking at the dice. Keep it fun.

Literacy-

Children, I would like you to keep learning to recognise what your name looks like. We are continuing to do this here at kinder. I want you to do a pasting activity at home. Can you make a name rocket? You will need some scissors, some glue, some paper. If you have any star stickers, you can use them too. Or you can cut out some stars. Please ask Mum or Dad to help you with the writing of letters. If you do this activity, I would love to see it.

Parents, please help your child to safely use scissors. Can you mix the letters up and see if your child can put them in order correctly? Can they recognise any letters? As always, please keep it fun.
